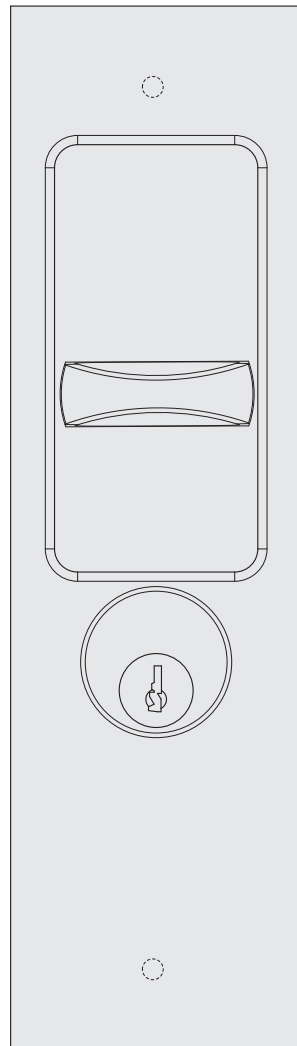


Sliding Door Compression Locks

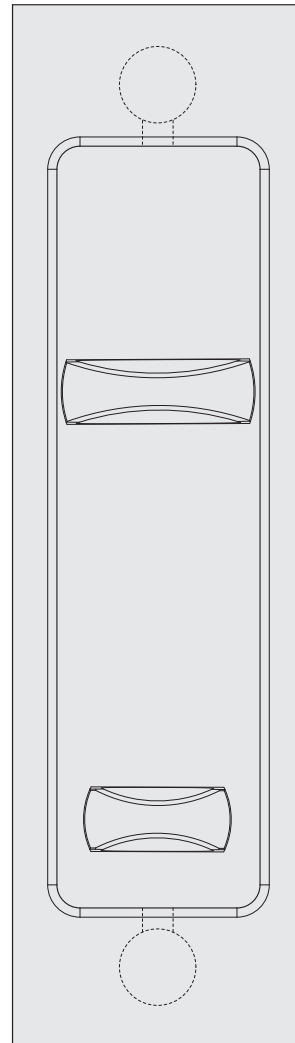
Key Cylinder
"Locks and unlocks"
the lock



1-Piece 6620

Compression Turn
Throws the locking
bolt and then pulls
the doors together.

Thumb Turn
"Locks and unlocks"
the lock



1-Piece 6631

How to Lock a SDCL

* **Note** Doors must be fully compressed before locking with Thumb Turn or Key Cylinder.

1. Slide doors together.
2. Rotate **Compression Turn** to throw the locking bolt and pull the doors together.
3. Rotate **Thumb Turn/Key Cylinder** to lock the sliding doors, **once doors are compressed**.

One piece flush pull is machined from billet, or partially machined casting.

Two piece has a screwed on black plate, suitable for electroplating

Door Locking Sequence and Thumb Turn Positions
